Why is Locational Geography Important?

Locational Understanding Across the Curriculum

Powerful anecdotes from subject lead HMIs:

 Despite studying the Roman Empire and its impact on Britain in depth, pupils could not locate Italy or Rome on a European map or globe.

A powerful opportunity to embed locational knowledge lost.

HMI Subject Lead Geography, Primary Geography Spring 2021:

 Despite obvious enjoyment of a class text, some pupils believed that the WW2 refugee had arrived in England from Australia, rather than Austria.

Locational confusion.

The use of Digimap for Schools develops and secures locational knowledge across the curriculum.




